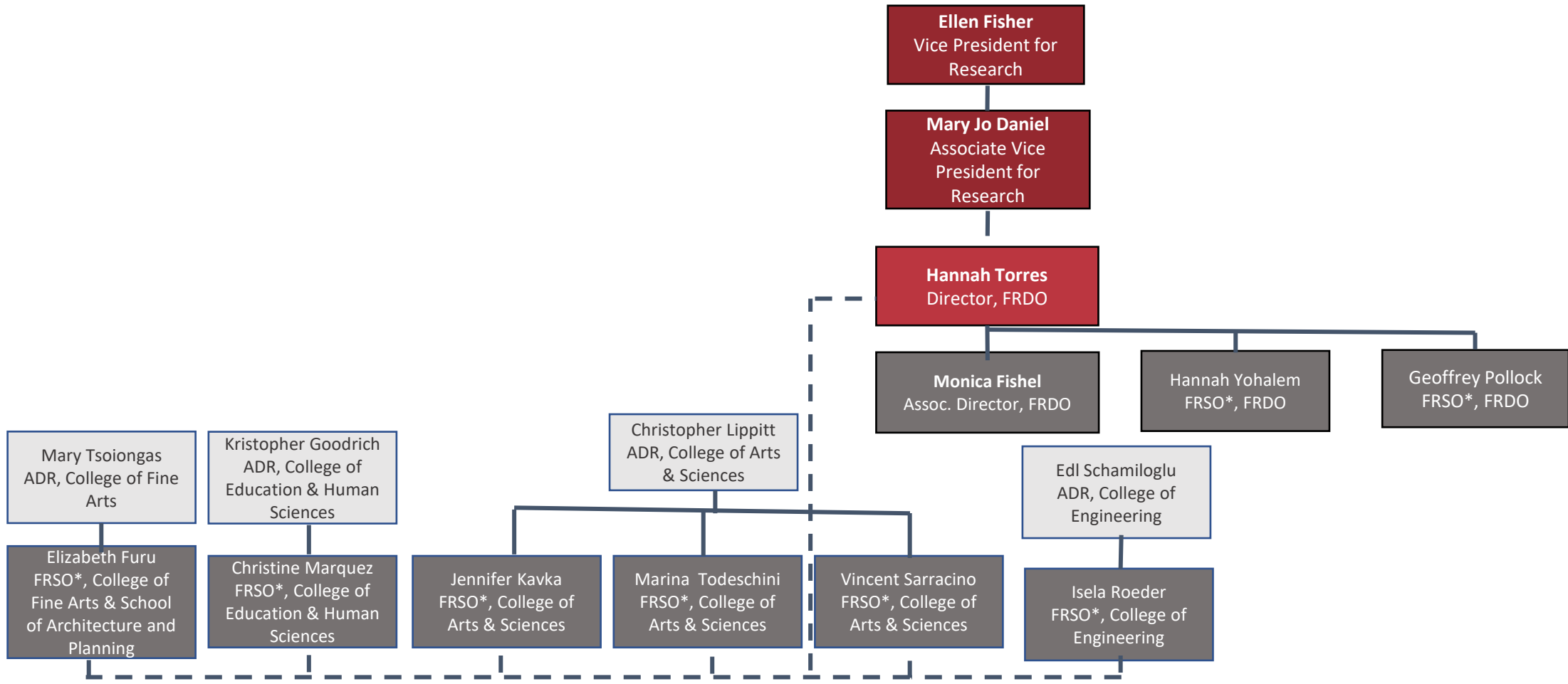

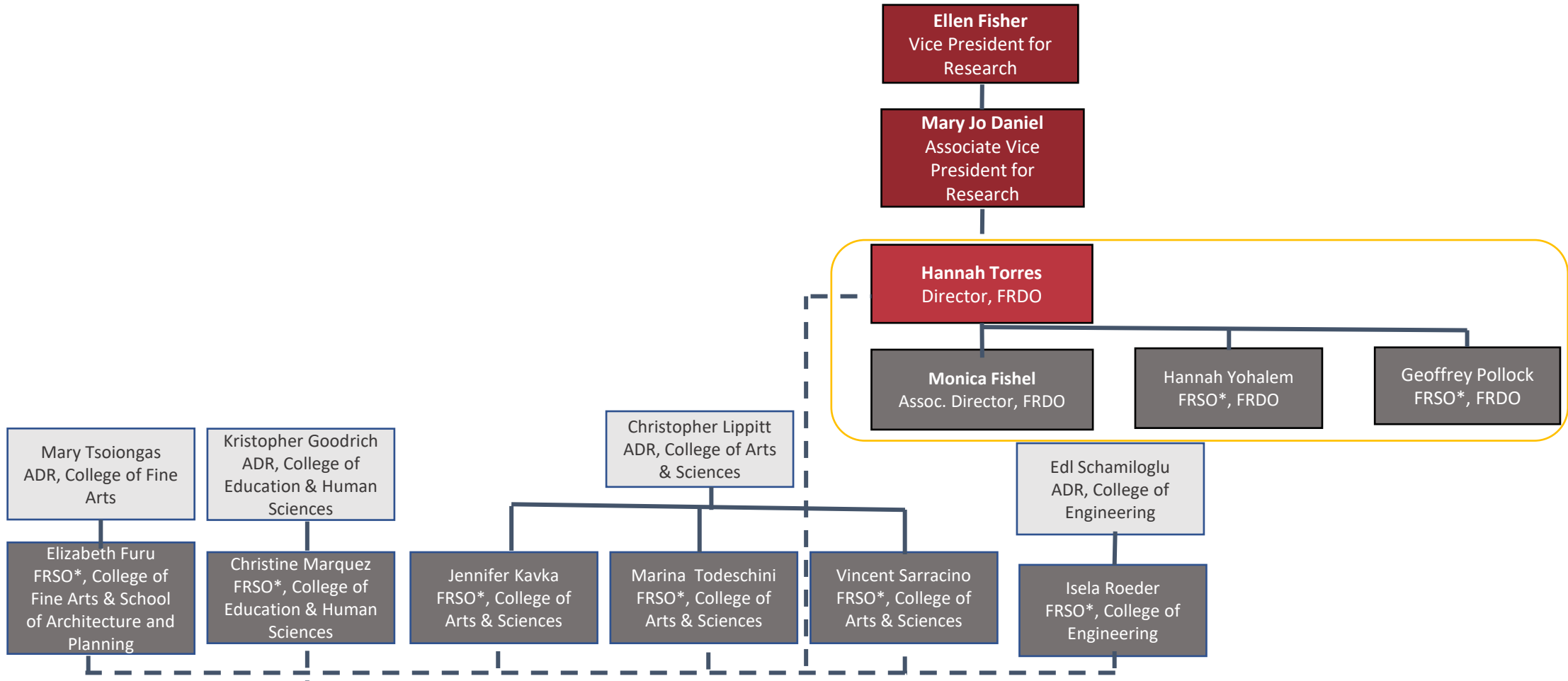
Faculty Research Development Office (FRDO) and Network

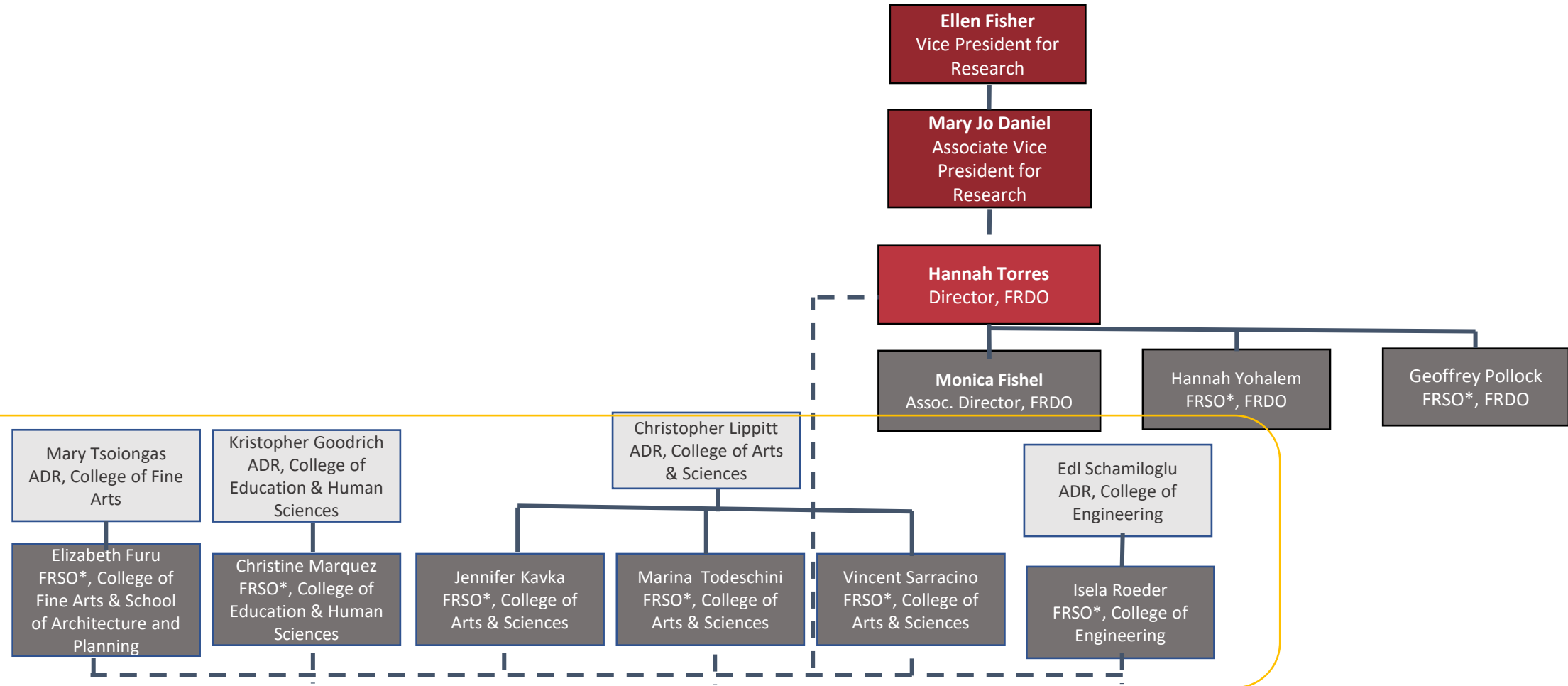

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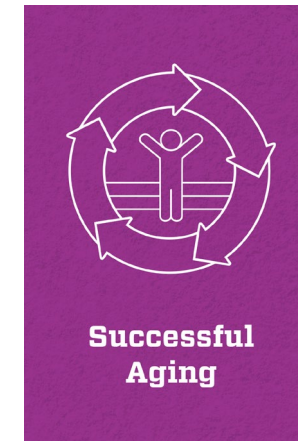

Office of the Vice President for Research: Grand Challenges

- Presidential Initiative started in 2018
- 3 Grand Challenges selected in Spring 2019
- 3 years of support for each team



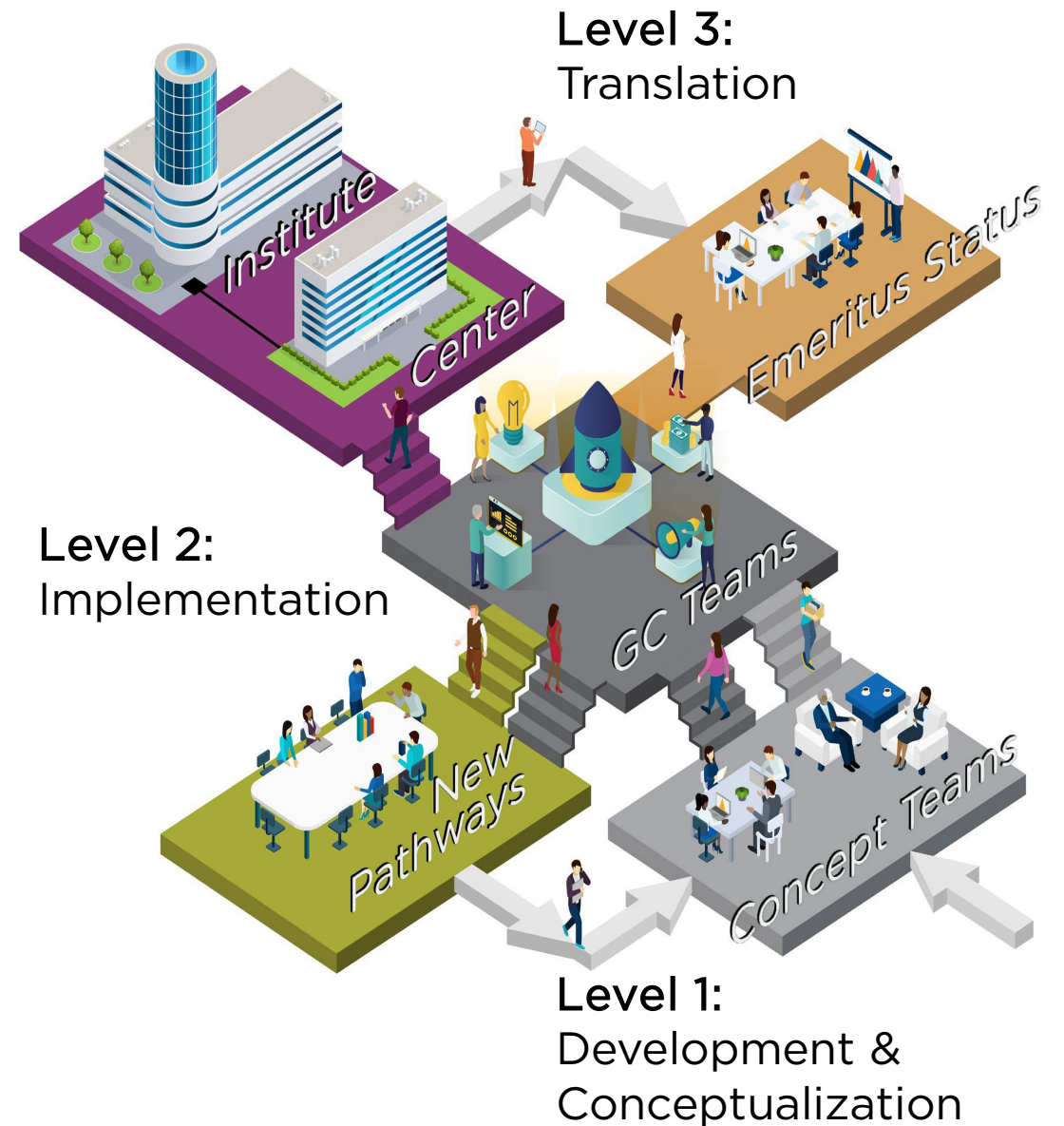
Outcomes include:

- Publications, presentations, and media documenting research outcomes that address the challenges
- 3 large externally-funded Centers (\$35M+)
- Pilot programs turned into externally-funded research programs

Grand Challenges Reimagined

Creates 3-level program

- Level 1: Creation of Concept Teams
- Level 2: Selection of new GC teams
- Level 3: Next Steps/Leveling up
